3	Global Campaign	Collect 10.000 signatures for JTFE Stop the Slaughter of People with Albinism Global Petition to be submitted to the African Union and the UN in December 2018.

Awareness raising banners/billboard installed at 15 major stadiums.
6	Family re-unification	Proceed with family re-unification where possible, with focus on establishing close community follow-up mechanism.
7	Child sponsorship/PWA individual support for self-sustainability	Select 10 students per year to support for making prominent role models
