### African Union Plan of Action on Albinism (2021- 2031)

#### AT A GLANCE

The Plan of Action to End Attacks and Other Human Rights Violations Targeting Persons with Albinism in Africa (2021-2031) is a 10-year plan that forms part of the African Unions's efforts to implement its African Union Disability Architecture including the AU Disability Protocol.

THE AFRICAN UNION PLAN OF ACTION ON ALBINISM IS AN EXTENSION OF THE REGIONAL ACTION PLAN (2017-2021)

#### **ADOPTION**

The AU PoA was adopted in 2019 by the African Union Executive Council at its 35th ordinary session.

#### **AN INCLUSIVE PROCESS**

The AU PoA 's implementation matrix is informed by the Regional Action Plan (2017-2021) Report and a 2-Day consultation in November 2020 with organizations representing people with albinism, the African Union, National Human Rights Institutions and the United Nations.

Strategic outcomes, priority actions, responsible entities, indicators & data collection mechanisms are outlined to achieve the Plan's measures.



The responsible entities to achieve the goals in the plan are Member States, ministries, partner organizations, and other stakeholders.



A Results-based management approach to promote stakeholder participation in the implementation of the Plan and promote accountability at a national level.



A Special Envoy on Albinism to be appointed will ensure the implementation of the Plan.
